Other Items

- Donations In our last meeting, Trevor suggested that we accept donations during registration, and this was approved by the board. This has been implemented on the registration form.
- New Tools As prescribed by the national office we are using two new tools in support of our regional financials. As of today, these are not fully set up, but good progress is being made.
 - Divvy this is a platform that provides for budgeted spending / payments through virtual and physical master cards, as well as a reimbursement approach which provides reimbursement directly into the requestor's bank account. This reduces risk involved with physical checks, and provides appropriate approval mechanisms and full tracking and reporting. To date, the platform is linked to our Homestead bank account, and we are actively testing the payment and reimbursement funcitons. Divvy provides ease of upload for supporting documentation / receipts.
 - ZipBooks this platform provides a reporting platform for our region and for national. It is similar
 to Quickbooks, but does not have a built-in budget feature. We will continue to do our annual
 budgets (due each July) through MS Excel. Zipbooks is also tied to our bank account successfully,
 and since November we have been able to categorize our transactions into the appropriate
 budget area.
